Community Liaison Chairman's Comment

There has been recent comment in the community that there is little or no feedback from the Community Liaison Committee (CLC) with the result that many people are unaware of our presence or purpose. That is probably fair comment, although any lack of feedback was unintentional and our presence was of course highlighted in this Newsletter. It is now intended that each Community Newsletter will now include a Chairman's Comment with the intent of rectifying that.

The existence of the Committee was a condition of the original Consent issued for the operation of the Redvale Landfill. The Consent calls for the Committee to meet four times per year. The Committee has no formal powers and its purpose is, as its name suggests, to act as a liaison between the local community and Waste Management. We have no power to change or enforce anything but we can and do monitor current activities and issues to ensure the communities interests are represented to the best of our ability. This all sounds a bit toothless but the "squeaky wheel" principal does apply and Waste Management have generally been receptive to measures we have suggested or requested to keep the community as happy as possible. There are of course still the ongoing problems with noise and odour, and Waste Management continue to investigate and implement new measures to mitigate that.

Previously the Committee has met three times a year plus a Christmas meeting.. That was sufficient during quiet non contentious times but given the current Consent Application process there is case for more regular meetings to be held and accordingly meetings have now been changed to quarterly plus a Christmas meeting.

Many (hopefully most) of you will be aware that Waste Management have recently applied for an extension to the life of the landfill.

The main points are:-

Under the original consent the landfill can operate until 2023.

Waste Management sought an extension to operate until 2049.

The Independent Commissioners rejected that length of time and granted a 5 year extension until end 2028. Waste Management have since appealed that decision and sought a modified extension to 2039.

That appeal will be heard early July.

The Committee are not involved in this process but community interests are being represented by the Redvale Environmental Protection Society Inc. (REPS). The Consent process involves a lot more than just a simple time extension and you should all, particularly those living in close proximity to the landfill, investigate how those changes may affect you.

I also need to comment on the Proposed Auckland Unitary Plan (PAUP) and the submissions Waste Management have made. In particular they are seeking to be re-designated as a "Special Zone" which, if granted could/would see a 1 kilometre overlay, from

the landfill foot print, applied. In effect this could/would mean activities sensitive to noise/odour, and air discharges, are limited. This includes new residential activities (subdivision). Again, those living in close proximity to the landfill need to be aware of this and how it may affect you.

There are many avenues available to investigate where these processes are up to now but for convenience it may be easiest to contact REPS directly. They do not have a website but there are four local REPS members who have indicated they are happy to be used as a contact point. Those people are:-

Redvale Landfill

Landfill operations have been very busy over recent months, with the bulk annual earthworks program coming to a close, as it is essentially complete. The new cell is ready, and the final capping and restoration work on the northern and eastern slopes will be finalised shortly. The new wheelwash will be arriving from Europe in May. The paving and foundation work for the new internal road system and foundation work is well underway, and will be completed in the next 4 to 6 weeks.

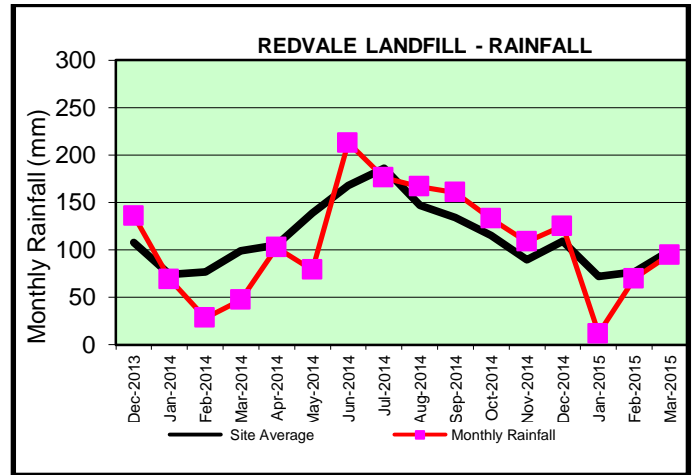
Landfill operations have been at RL100 and will continue there for some time. The new compaction equipment, the latest CAT 836K will be arriving mid-year, the first in this country, to replace one of the existing units. Taking on board the comments and concerns raised by residents during the consenting process, we have carefully considered the equipment specification and have given more attention to noise and how it can be reduced, as well as safety improvement options. The new machine will arrive with the latest in noise suppression both for the in cab operator, and external noise during operation. Going forward, all new equipment will be specified with enhanced noise suppression, where applicable.

The acoustic screen adjacent to the Blower Station in the Energy Park has been installed already. The detailed design of the acoustic screen adjacent to the generators is also underway.

The consent renewal process is now in the appeals stage, with parties working towards the Environment court. Submissions by all parties are due to be lodged at the court by 15th May.

The work in partnership with the Dairy Flat Pony Club on the use of WM land for equestrian activities has been initiated. Works will be undertaken in the next couple of months to prepare the grounds for club nights and events throughout the 2015/16 calendar. This fits in well with our overall plans to provide positive benefit to the surrounding Dairy Flat community.

Grant Monies available in 2015/2016

I thought this information could be helpful to our community of Dairy Flat.

The Rodney Local Board is presently setting the guidelines for Community Grants for 2015/2016 from Auckland Council.

These guidelines are designed to build capacity for community groups and organisations to deliver sustainable outcomes in their neighbourhood. So what do outcomes look like?

Outcomes

Presently Local Board Community grants 2014 focus upon:

- Roads, paths and public transport enable us to get around easily and safely (page 16 – 19).
- Parks and sports facilities are easy to access and enjoy (page 20 – 25).
- Communities are empowered and plan for their own futures (26 – 29).
- Our environment is healthy, cared for and enjoyed (page 30 – 33).
- Local halls and libraries are familiar, valued and well used community spaces (page 34 – 37).
- Local economies are strong and growing (page 38 – 41).
- Arts, culture and events enhance our communities and express who we are (page 42 – 45).

On the 1st July 2015 a new grants process will commence for the new financial year 2015/2016 with priority being given to these events.

- Roads, paths and public transport enable us to get around easily and safely: Our communities are well connected by transport links and have a range of transport options available to them.
- Parks and sports facilities are easy to access and enjoy: Our communities, young and old, will have increased access to a wide range of recreation opportunities for health, well-being and enjoyment. For example, I am thinking of Wainui School accessing the Village Green.
- Communities are empowered and plan for their own futures: Our communities know what they want for their future. Local people will plan for their own areas and determine what is important.
- Our environment is healthy, cared for and enjoyed by all: Local community groups take ownership in the quality of their environment.

River and stream water quality will be improving, pest species reduced and waste minimised. Our wastewater servicing will be reliable and environmentally friendly.

- Local economies are strong and growing: Our local economy will strengthen, and businesses will thrive through working together. A growing economy will provide more jobs for local people.
- Arts, culture and events enhance our communities and express who we are: Our communities will celebrate, learn and grow through arts, culture, events and a variety of community-led initiatives. These activities will strengthen communities, provide opportunities for people to connect with each other and build a sense of pride.

Investment Approach

The Rodney Local Board in 2015/2016 has allocated budgets to support the local grants programme as follows:

- Match funding under either quick response or local grants is encouraged and will be given preference when considering applications.
- Quick Response Local Grants:
 - Minimum amount per grant: \$500
 - Maximum amount per grant: \$2,000
- Local Grants:
 - Minimum amount per grant: \$2,000
 - Maximum amount per grant: \$10,000

The Magic of Autumn

The most wonderful season of the year!

Soil temperatures are still reasonable so growth is still good. Soil moisture has risen slightly, OK that's not quite as good as it could be and grass growth is a bit retarded, excluding the lawn. But it's great to be in the garden!

Lots of pruning's from shrubbery, vege garden and lawn clippings mean ample ingredients for the compost, don't forget to get it moist enough if you really want to get some heat generated!

Right Plant Wrong Place?

Ideally a tree/shrub gets planted once and left for perpetuity, reality sometimes differs....? That's OK it can be moved, even quite large trees relocate if some simple rules are followed.

Evergreens and conifers are best moved in Autumn, and deciduous trees while they're dormant (i.e. no leaves) during winter. Young trees relocate best, the older the tree the greater the shock, like us all. Conifers don't prune well and are very reluctant to regrow new shoots from the old wood. Wrenching (digging up) is done over a period of about 6 weeks, before the tree is relocated.

How to:

1. Measure the diameter of the trunk at about 1 m. above the ground, multiply by 10. This gives you the approx. distance out from the base to start digging; I always allow a bit more.
2. Only dig on 2 sides, (i.e. Nth and Sth), to cut the surface roots. Go down about a spade depth and leave for 2 weeks the trench can be filled with compost, to stop the roots drying out.
3. After 2 weeks, repeat the performance on the remaining 2 sides. Leave for 2 weeks.
4. If the soil is dry the plant may require some extra water, fill the trench up with water.
5. Prepare the new site, mixing in plenty of compost with the existing soil and some crystal rain. Make sure the sides of the new hole are really rough and uneven to allow water a greater opportunity to drain out as well as in! Oh don't forget to make sure the hole is in the right place before planting this time!
6. Now to cut the tap roots. Not always a major but with big specimens help is often required to pull the tree so as to get access underneath.
7. Help may also be needed to relocate it. Placing the root ball on a sack and dragging the sack is better than dragging the roots across the ground, the plant will need those.
8. When upright (the plant) ensure its facing the way it will be viewed from. Stake larger specimens to give support so the roots have a chance to re-establish.
9. With evergreens some pruning of the top growth may be beneficial to help reduce the rate of transpiration. The reduced root area may not be able to keep up otherwise although this isn't always necessary.
10. If the specimen is tall, it might be easier to prune it before standing it up.
11. Go and have a beer!

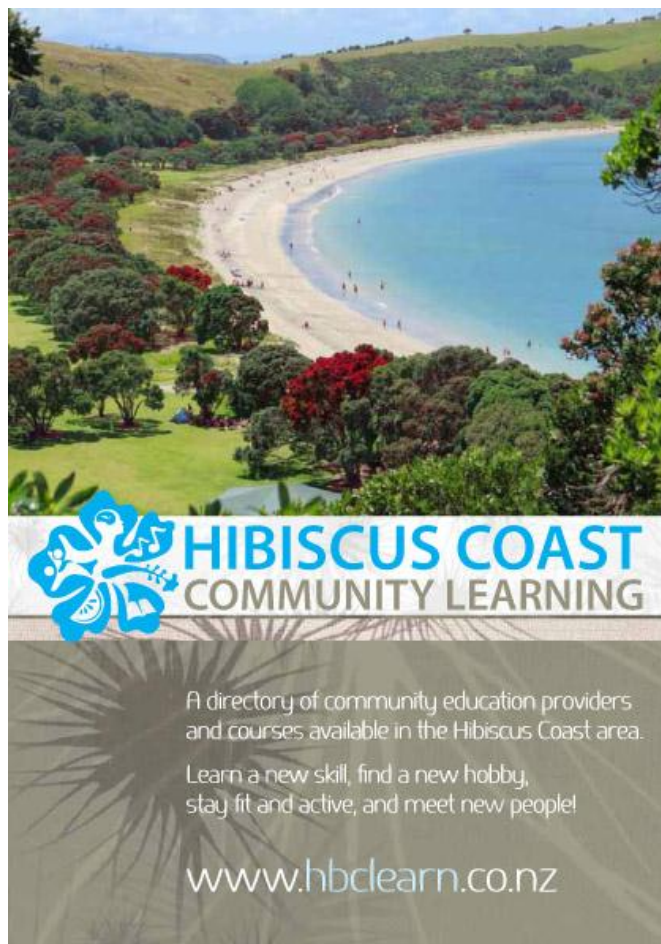
